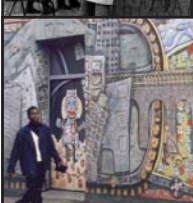
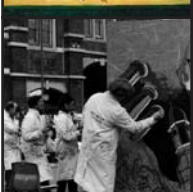
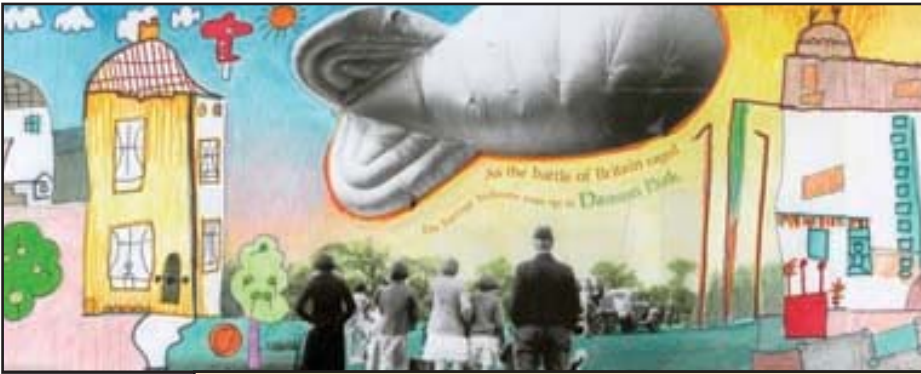

## The most ancient art

Mural painting dates back to mans earliest history and can be seen throughout our history and cultures. Creating your own mural is an exciting way to join together to improve our environment and the possibilities are endless.

## Creative involvement

Creating a mural consists of four basic stages:-

**Consultation and research** - including setting the theme, measuring the site, historical research, photographic projects...

**Design** - creating the artwork that will form the basis of the final mosaic. Final design work is carried out by the artist.

**Painting** - either directly on site or on moveable panels

**Completion** - further painting of the mural and varnishing.

School pupils can be involved in any or all of the first three stages. Health and safety considerations make involvement in the final stage unsuitable.
